**Upcoming WIS 167 Roadway Closure Near Interstate 41**

**Richfield, WI...** The Village of Richfield is notifying motorists of an upcoming full closure of WIS 167 (Holy Hill Road), between I-41 and Wolf Road, just west of the Interstate. Beginning on Monday, October 21st, WIS 167 will be closed until approximately mid-November. During this closure, WIS 167 will be widened over the railroad track crossing, infrastructure for a new signalized intersection will be installed, a driveway for a local business will be realigned and a new Village road will be constructed east of the railroad tracks to service the new Kwik Trip gas station currently under construction. An official detour will be posted along WIS 175, County Road Y (Lannon Road) and I-41. This work is weather dependent and subject to change.

“As information related to the closure becomes available, including timelines, we encourage residents to visit to visit our website and social media accounts where regular updates will be posted until the completion of the infrastructure work on WIS 167. This has been a busy year for road construction in the Village. We are grateful to our residents and those who commute through our community daily that they have been respectful of construction work zones and above-all, cognizant of worker safety. As we near the last 30 days of road construction in the Village for 2019, we want to express our gratitude for the patience and understanding of our taxpayers” said Village Administrator Jim Healy.
